

# Ghilarducci ordered to appear and produce documents

A federal bankruptcy court issued an order Wednesday requir-

ing former Humboldt Creamery CEO Rich Ghilarducci to appear for examination in Eureka on July 1 at the law offices of William Bertain.

Ghilarducci was also ordered to produce a list of

documents by June 24 to the San Francisco law offices of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones involving the creamery's financing, his communication with banks and "all documents evidencing your alterations to

the debtor's financial statements," according to the order filed by the attorney for the unsecured creditors committee.

Emails and calls to Ghilarducci's attorney by *The Enterprise* were not

returned.

Along with financial statements, the order asks for all documents that refer or relate to borrowing against any accounts held by the debtor and "all documents that refer or relate

to a payment of \$200,000" allegedly made by the CEO in February 2008 to the creamery.
